

Data Use Agreement for the Jena Organization Corpus (JOCO)

JOCO is a corpus of annual reports and corporate social responsibility reports of US American, British and German enterprises spanning a time interval from the late nineties up to today. It is intended to be used in a shared community effort to improve natural language processing techniques for analyses in the economic language domain (common research endeavor).

Since JOCO comprises copyright-protected material, it is distributed in accordance with the 2018 amendment to the German copyright law (*Urheberrechts-Wissensgesellschafts-Gesetz*, effective from March 1, 2018) allowing for corpora to be shared with a limited number of people for a common research endeavor (see above).

JOCO is provided by the Chair of Organization, Leadership, and Human Resource Management, Prof. Dr. Peter Walgenbach, and the Chair of Computational Linguistics, Prof. Dr. Udo Hahn, both from Friedrich-Schiller-Universität Jena, Germany (corpus providers) under the following terms:

1. JOCO may only be used for non-commercial research activities.
2. JOCO may not be distributed. Rather than re-distributing JOCO yourself (e.g., to your collaborators), all prospective users of JOCO must fill out this data use agreement individually. If you are interested in extending JOCO, please get in touch with the corpus providers.
3. In accordance with German copyright law (see above), JOCO and all of its copies must be deleted once the common research endeavor is completed. The arrival of this event is stipulated by the corpus providers. The corpus providers declare that they request the deletion of JOCO copies only when they deem this step necessary under German copyright law.
4. JOCO is provided free of charge.
5. JOCO comes with absolutely no warranties including (but not limited to) the correctness of the information provided in the text corpus itself.
