

International Students Coming to the University of Bologna

• **Nomination:**

Please e-mail us the Erasmus nominees for 2017/2018 to incoming.diri@unibo.it providing the following details:

- full name, date of birth and e-mail address
- period of stay (first semester, second semester, full academic year)
- subject area code of the exchange and university campus (Bologna, Forlì, Cesena, Ravenna, Rimini)

We accept students whose nomination has been communicated within the following deadlines:

July 1st 2017 for the 1st semester (September 2017- January 2018) or full academic year

December 1st 2017 for the 2nd semester (February 2018-July 2018)

• **Application:** As soon as we make the registration, nominated students will receive an email with the invitation to register on line.

Important: students are not allowed to register prior to having received the e-mail of acceptance.

Useful information

- There is not a mandatory date of arrival but the students should check the academic calendar of the faculty of their interest to know about the starting date of the courses.

- As soon as they arrive to our University incoming students **should go to the International Office of their city-campus (Bologna Ravenna Forlì Rimini and Cesena)** to register and to collect their student badge, exam booklet and to have their Certificate of Attendance filled out and signed.
- The University of Bologna does not require a mandatory number of ECTS for each term.
- There is not a minimum level of Italian language formally required, but since most of the courses are in Italian it is strongly advisable that the students have a minimum knowledge of the language (A2) or that they come early enough to attend the course offered by our University. It is also recommended a B1 level for courses taught in English.
- Incoming students can attend an Italian language course free of charge.
Courses are held twice a year: in September-October for students arriving in the 1st semester and in January-March for students arriving in the 2nd semester.
Each student can attend only one course, and more precisely, only the course held in his/her semester of arrival.
- The courses are organised in Bologna campus by the university language centre, CLA .
Students who wish to attend the course must complete an on-line self- evaluation questionnaire on their knowledge of Italian as well as an on-line placement test. Please check the CLA website for the on-line questionnaire and placement test and for the deadlines.
